History The British Society of Baking was founded in 1955 as an affiliate of the American Society of Bakery Engineers. We retain our affiliation and links with the American Society, now called the American Society of Baking, exchanging publications and information, although we operate as an autonomous body.

Purpose The primary purpose of the British Society of Baking is to provide a forum for learning more about the baking industry through conferences and associated events, together with networking and the exchange of information and ideas between members.

Membership Members come from all areas of the baking industry and its associated suppliers, including: retail, plant and instore bakeries; ingredient and equipment suppliers; flour millers; research associations; and education establishments. Bakery students and trainees are also very welcome as members.
